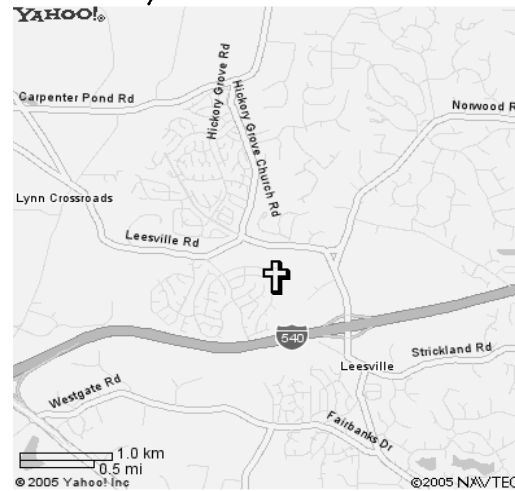

From US-1:

- Take US-1 to I-540 (heading WEST toward Durham).
- Follow I-540 WEST to exit 7 (Leesville Rd)
- Turn RIGHT at the exit ramp onto Leesville Rd.
- Follow Leesville Rd. for almost 1 mile.
- Church is on the left

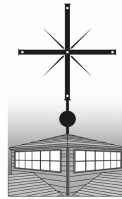
